

Volume II: Glossary of the Code of Practice for the Defined Interstate Rail Network

RISSB has produced a first draft document based on the former Volume II: Glossary of the Code of Practice for the Defined Interstate Rail Network (COP for the DIRN). This Guideline, now known as the Glossary of Railway Terminology is intended as a national guideline which includes previous terminology for the DIRN, but also extends to railway terminology generally (i.e. not just the DIRN, but the national rail network).

This document will:

- Supersede Volume II of the COP for the DIRN, and
- Be a “living document”, being updated in accordance with the issuance of other RISSB documents.

It is classed as a RISSB Guideline because it is NOT mandatory or normative, but informative.
