What is needed from your organisation?

Your organisation will need to:

- Provide a nominator who should be a line manager/senior manager who is prepared to be the primary RISSB contact within the organisation for this program and a mentor for the participant.
- Cover all costs for the program which include the course fee of \$1,950 (plus GST) for members and \$2,490 (plus GST) for non-members as well as all travel and accommodation costs for each stage of the program including travel to forums and development group meetings, as well as the discounted registration cost for RISSB Rail Safety Conference.
- Ensure the nominee is available for the Horizons Program kick-off forum as well as other forums and meetings scheduled for 2019 and 2020 (on dates to be advised).
