Publish a new good practice Guideline titled **Positive Safety Culture In The Rail Corridor**.

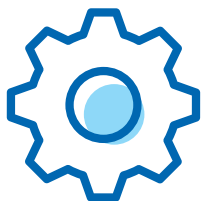
In conjunction with ACRI and ONRSR, release a report identifying **world-class safety technologies that can minimise risk to Australian track workers**.
