How to become a member

We offer two types of membership:

Full Members

Full Members enjoy all the benefits and rights of RISSB membership.

Any entity or organisation (incorporated or otherwise) will be eligible to be a full member of the company if it is an entity that is:

- (a) An accredited rail transport operator (either as a rail infrastructure manager or a rolling stock operator or both), whether within Australia or overseas
- (b) A government agency or organisation that controls the management of rail networks by a rail transport operator
- (c) A contractor or supplier supplying services or equipment to the Industry
- (d) An association with a key focus on the Industry.

Associate Members

Associates have access to RISSB & its services but are not eligible to vote at any General Meeting or elect or nominate a Director to the Board.

Associate membership is available to organisations and individuals who meet the following criteria:

- (a) An individual, small contractor or supplier with three or less staff and a turnover of less than \$1M per annum supplying services or equipment to the Industry
- (b) Distinguished individuals who have given long and meritorious service to the Industry and whose activities promote or have promoted the objects of the Company
- (c) Individuals who are engaged in studies associated with the Industry
- (d) An employee union, higher education institution or registered training organisation, who has an interest in the Industry generally
- (e) A tourism and/or heritage organisation that is a registered charitable organisation and has operations turnover of less than \$1 million per annum.

Membership Classes & Fees

Full members are split into eight classes which are related to each member's annual turnover from Australian or New Zealand rail related activities. For members who join between 1 October and 31 March a pro rata fee will apply. For members who join after 1 April there will be no fee for the current year but the fee



for the following financial year will apply. Membership fees are not refundable.
